


Transmit Design

The **Transmit Design** feature provides users the option to package their designs, making it easier to share with clients and collaborators.

InfoDrainage saves the packaged design into the same folder as the open .iddx file by default. To save the package into a different folder, click "browse" and navigate to the desired location.

While the packaged file automatically includes the network data, templates, and rainfall data, additional items such as Results, GIS Data, CAD Data, Images, and Surface Data can be included by simply clicking the appropriate checkboxes. Note that if the Include Images checkbox is checked, for each image its corresponding world file is also included, if it exists.
